Responsibility:

It is the rider, or persons responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions of this show. Conditions are published in the schedule.

Official start time: The official event start time is 8am Friday 11TH January, 2019. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note Dressage NZ rule 477 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.

Competitor Entrance:

Stable and Yarding:

Moving horses to unallocated yards or stable is prohibited.

The Stable Manager only may authorise stabling and yarding changes.

Please make sure horse poo goes in skips provided and other rubbish goes in rubbish bins.

Hay will be available for purchase on the grounds – via Simon Washer of Farmfeed – 0274 262 036. Hay can also be pre-ordered to pick up on arrival. Discount for Dressage Taranaki members. eftpos available.

Arena Familiarisation Times:

All Competition Arenas (Oval & Indoor) are closed at all times except as stated below.

These times may be amended depending on entries please check times in rider notes provided with the draw.

Arena familiarisation is not intended to be used as a full schooling session.

Riders need to be considerate of other riders wishing to familiarise their horses.

Indoor Arena:

Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate. Maximum of 3 horses in the actual arena at any one time.

Outdoor Arena:

Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace only around the exterior of the arenas

TSB Indoor Arena Rules:

Maximum of 3 horses permitted in the Indoor at any one time – the 1 competing and the next 2 horses competing in the arena. When warming up in the indoor arena please be mindful of the rider and horse competing before you.

Please no lunging of horses in the indoor for the duration of the tournament.

Please warm up on the outdoor surfaced arena.

General Rules:

Lunging is not permitted in the Indoor, warm up arena or in the Oval. Designated area to be confirmed, please enquire at event reception for further information.

Please check your times during the show as classes may be condensed if there are lots of scratchings.

All horses/ponies must wear an ID tag at all times while on the grounds with the rider name and contact phone number.

All Dressage Taranaki competitions will be run under the current (2016) ESNZ Gr's, VR's and ESNZ Rules of Dressage

The organising committee retains the right to refuse entry, alter the schedule, alter advertised times and cancel or divide classes as it deems necessary within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules for Dressage.

The Organising Committee disclaims all liability in accordance with Article 136 ESNZ Gen Regs.

Hats – ESNZ approved riding hats must be worn always, at all levels, during the competition.

All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the organising committee gives permission otherwise.

All competitors and visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/DNZ and Egmont A&P Showgrounds Health & Safety Policies.

No dogs are allowed in any stable or yarding area, warm up, competition areas or buildings. Dogs must be on a lead at all times. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damaged/harm caused by the dog at the competition.

Please keep the facilities tidy and clean.

Please pick up all horse poo and put it in the bin 😊
